FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q. What is a Fraternity or Sorority?
A. A fraternity or sorority is a group of men or women formed by a brotherhood or sisterhood and common academic, civic/organizations, jobs, family and friends. The time management skills that are learned from fraternity or sorority, commonly called a Greek organization, stronger. Their common experience builds the trust that a lifetime.

Q. Do Greek organizations take up a lot of time?
A. While membership does require a time commitment, Greeks are known for balancing their time between academics, clubs/organizations, jobs, family and friends. The time management skills that are learned from fraternity or sorority, commonly called a Greek organization, stronger. Their common experience builds the trust that a lifetime.

Q. Who is eligible to participate in recruitment/initiate?
A. Attaining a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and have earned at least 12 credits towards graduation.
Completed all Basic Skills classes (if applicable).
Filled out and submitted the "New Member Registration Form" to the Office of Greek Affairs.
Filled out and submitted the "Information on Indemnification and Hazing for all Greek New Members Form" to the Office of Greek Affairs.
Completion of the "New Member Workshop" presented by the Office of Greek Affairs.
Please Note: First semester transfer students will be required to submit an official transcript from their previous institution to verify cumulative GPA eligibility. Students matriculating through the Educational Opportunity Fund/Maximizing Academic Potential program must seek the approval of their counselor prior to joining a Greek-letter organization.

Q. Will my academics be compromised by joining a Greek organization?
A. On the contrary, a capital mission of all Greek organizations is academic excellence. Fraternities and sororities understand that their members are students first and foremost. All chapters have academic programs that may include required study hours, tutoring, scholarships and other recognition programs for academic success.

Q. Is there a financial cost to joining Greek Life?
A. Like any opportunity for involvement in college, there is a financial commitment associated with joining a fraternity or sorority. The costs go toward the inter/national fees, chapter operating expenses, and social functions. Financial obligations differ among individual chapters. New members can expect to pay higher dues their first semester than in subsequent ones for one time initiation/application fees. There are payment plans available for students, as well as scholarships within the individual chapters. While you are participating in the recruitment process, make sure that you ask about the financial obligations of membership.

Q. What is recruitment/initiate?
Recruitment/initiate is the time when Greek organizations seek and recruit new members. Students have the opportunity to go to know the different groups and see what each has to offer. Also during this time, potential new members go through a mutual selection process to determine which organization they will join. Membership intake is the process that NPHC and cultural-based organizations utilize to select, educate, and initiate new members.

GREEK FACTS

- 44% of U.S. Presidents have held fraternity membership.
- 50% of the top 10 Fortune 500 CEO's are fraternity men.
- Greek students rate their college life happier than other collegians.
- Greeks are more likely to graduate than other collegians.
- Fraternity alumni are more supportive to their universities than non-Greek alumni.
- 76% of the Men & Women in Who's Who in America have been Greek.
- Greek students are more involved in campus activities and community groups after college.
- Nationally, 71% of all Greeks graduate, while only 50% of non-Greek students.
- Since 1910, 85% of the Supreme Court Justices have been Greek.
- 76% of Who's Who in America are Greek.
- 70% of the U.S. Presidents' cabinet members since 1900 have been Greek.
- 76% of U.S. Senators are Greek.
- Over 95% of the student leaders on 730 campuses are members of Greek-letter organizations.

HOW AND WHEN TO JOIN

FIRST: BE SURE YOU ARE ACADEMICALLY ELIGIBLE
Joining a Greek social organization without fully complying with all University requirements regarding eligibility is strictly prohibited. Both the individual student and the organization will be subject to disciplinary action for new membership violations. The following requirements pertain to students joining either recognized or unrecognized Greek social organizations. Full-time matriculated students are eligible for new membership when they have:

- Attained a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and have earned at least 12 credits towards graduation.
- Completed all Basic Skills classes (if applicable).
- Filed out and submitted the "New Member Registration Form" to the Office of Greek Affairs.
- Filed out and submitted the "Information on Indemnification and Hazing for all Greek New Members Form" to the Office of Greek Affairs.
- Completion of the "New Member Workshop" presented by the Office of Greek Affairs.

Please Note: First semester transfer students will be required to submit an official transcript from their previous institution to verify cumulative GPA eligibility. Students matriculating through the Educational Opportunity Fund/Maximizing Academic Potential program must seek the approval of their counselor prior to joining a Greek-letter organization.

SECOND: START YOUR RESEARCH

THIRD: ATTEND CHAPTER EVENTS
Recruitment and Intake events will be advertised via Social Media, Attention and Intake events will be advertised via Social Media, Attention flyers on campus and at sitting events in the Student Center. Attend chapter programs to learn more about the organization and meet the current members. Visit as many chapters as possible, and don't hesitate to ask questions, so that you know you've made the right choice.
